# Sunday 23RD APRIL 2023

Forest district Klokočná - close-to-nature forest management, Kutná Hora **UNESCO** 

Forest district Klokočná (Forests of the Czech Republic) - close-to-nature forest management, conversion of uniform even-aged forest stands into permanently structurally differentiated forests; Kutná Hora UNESCO: Historical Town Centre with the Church of St Barbara and the Cathedral of Our Lady at Sedlec.

## Monday 24TH APRIL 2023

Biodiversity data collection-soil, invertebrates, birds (East Bohemia)

Students will be introduced to current methods of collecting data on the biodiversity of temperate forests. We will review some data collection methods with the possibility of active participation. The lecture will be interspersed with a field trip to a diverse forest stand

### Tuesday 25TH APRIL 2023

Modern data collection methods in forestry, Arboretum, Goulash, Gril

Presentation of UAV technology for active and passive sensors for data collection. Including multispectral. thermal and lidar data. Participants can experience flying and FPV flying within the arboretum area, in connection with subsequent data processing and analysis. Refreshment on site.

### Wednesday 26TH APRIL 2023

Forests of CZU

Infrastructure and management of forest property on the example of the University forests. Nursery production, forest management, wood processing, associated production and care of historic buildings.

#### Thursday 27<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2023

Gamekeeping

Wildlife Management often requires a set of tools to properly monitor and implement management strategies. We will first go into the forest to examine some if these tools, including camera traps, feeding stations, and traps, and then have a look at the use of our multisensory collars. At the end, after a short introduction to remote-sensing using the collars, we will work with activity data of wild boar, visualize, and compare different parameters determining wild boar activity.
